SAMPLE 1: SHORT & SWEET

Our Opportunity:

RESULTS is creating a new advocacy chapter in Denver. This will be a group of passionate, committed community members who are willing take action to promote solutions to global poverty (increase access to health and nutrition, education, and economic opportunity). We'll meet twice a month, get updates on pressing global issues, learn powerful advocacy skills, and most important, take action together to make a difference. Help us build our core team!

Actions include:

- Meeting face to face with members of Congress and building relationships with their offices
- Writing pieces for the media
- Writing letters and making phone calls to decision makers
- Hosting community education events and calling on others in the community to take action with us
- Leadership opportunities are available for those seeking such experiences

Our Issues:

Since 1990, the number of children dying from preventable causes across the world has been cut by more than half, millions more kids are going to school, and we're on the path to ending AIDS. RESULTS has played an important role in these successes through our advocacy.

But we know there is still more work to do. This year, 5.6 million kids will die of a preventable cause before their 5th birthday, 300,000 women will die from a preventable pregnancy related cause, and millions of girls will miss out on their chance to go to school.

For the first time in history, we are faced with the fact that we have all of the resources needed to end these problems, ensuring that all kids are healthy, in school, and have the opportunity to reach their full potential.

The question isn't "Can we do this" but "Will we do what is needed to make this possibility a reality."

Our Mission

The past 25 years have seen tremendous improvements in global poverty. Preventable child deaths have been cut in half and millions of kids are in school for the first time. There is still work to do. This year, 5.9 million kids will die from preventable causes before they reach their

fifth birthday, 300,000 women will die from preventable pregnancy related causes, and 263 million kids will miss out on their chance to attend school.

For the first time in history, we have the resources that are necessary to end these deaths once and for all and make sure all kids have the chance to learn and grow. RESULTS advocates in Fargo are working to make this possibility a reality.

How We Work

RESULTS volunteers make a difference through citizen advocacy. Volunteers meet face to face with members of Congress, engage with the media, and communicate about global poverty and hunger issues in our community. RESULTS provides training, support, and inspiration to to help volunteers become skilled advocates. In time, RESULTS groups learn to effectively advise policy makers, guiding them towards decisions that will improve access to education, health, and economic opportunity.

Leadership Opportunity

As the leader of RESULTS Fargo, you will provide inspiration, guidance, and direction to our local team. Leadership duties include:

- 1. Convene two advocacy group meetings per month and facilitate communication between group members between meetings.
- 2. With support from staff, work with local advocates to strategize and carry out advocacy actions, including meeting with members of Congress, using the media, and educating the community about global poverty issues.
- 3. Attend regular calls with your RESULTS Regional Coordinator to stay up to date on global poverty news, actions, and opportunities.


RESULTS will provide leadership, issue, and advocacy training and support for the person chosen for this position.


