FY2025 Global Poverty Appropriations

LASER TALK**NOTES**

Engage: Investing in effective global health and education development assistance programs reduces poverty and suffering, creates strong allies, and is compassionate. These investments also make us safer here at home.

State the Problem: The State and Foreign Operations Subcommittee of Appropriations (SFOPS) will soon be making decisions for FY25. Will you please include RESULTS' global health and education requests in your submissions to SFOPS?

Inform: RESULTS FY2025 requests include \$1 billion for global tuberculosis; \$1.65 billion for the Global Fund to Fight AIDS, Tuberculosis and Malaria; \$1.15 billion for global maternal and child health (of which \$340 million would go to Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance); \$300 million for global nutrition; and \$1.15 billion for global basic education, of which \$200 million would go to the Global Partnership for Education.

Call to Action? Will you add these vital requests to your submissions to the State and Foreign Operations Subcommittee of Appropriations? Thanks for your leadership and for being open to input from your constituents.
