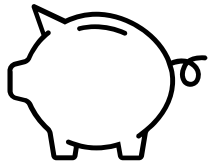

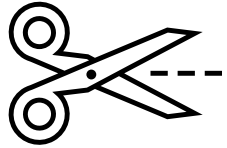
Laid groundwork for the re-introduction of the Renter Tax Credit

Began education lawmakers and grassroots on the impacts of recent Supreme Court case (Grants Pass v. Johnson)



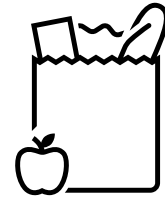
Placed several op-eds in local and national papers about housing affordability

Ensured the Special Supplemental Nutrition Program for Women, Infants and Children (WIC) saw increased funding and eliminated the \$1B deficit for the program



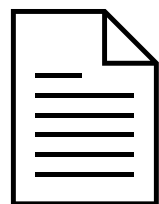
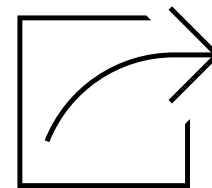
Created bi-partisan support for the removal of the federal felony ban on receiving food assistance

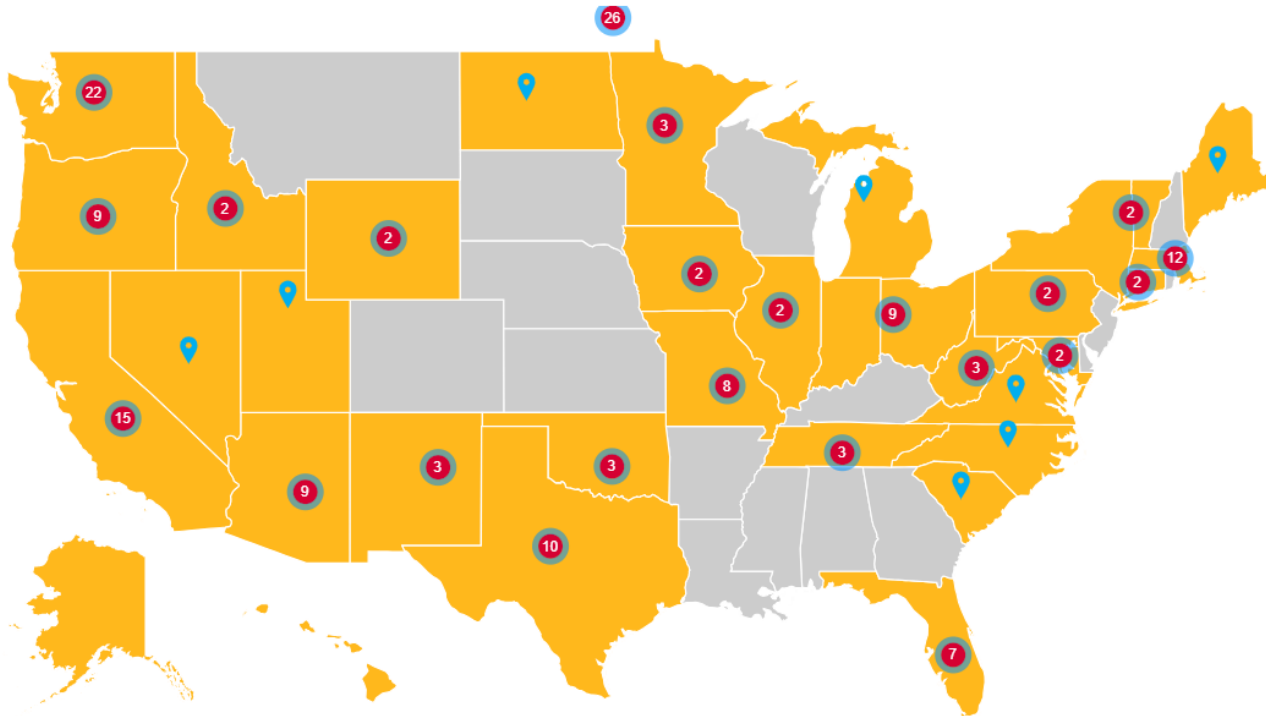

Congress has much to do, and we should help them do it before time runs out. Congress failed to pass a new farm bill on time, so the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program is in danger of running out of money by year's end. SNAP serves over 42 million food-insecure people per month.

The End Tuberculosis Now Act (HR 1776) is running out of time to pass. This bill would prioritize TB resources to priority areas and track success. The Senate already passed it. If the House doesn't pass it before the end of the year, we'll have to start over. Call now to urge U.S. Rep. Teresa Leger Fernández to pass these policies.

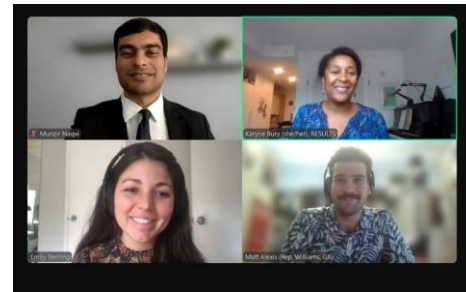

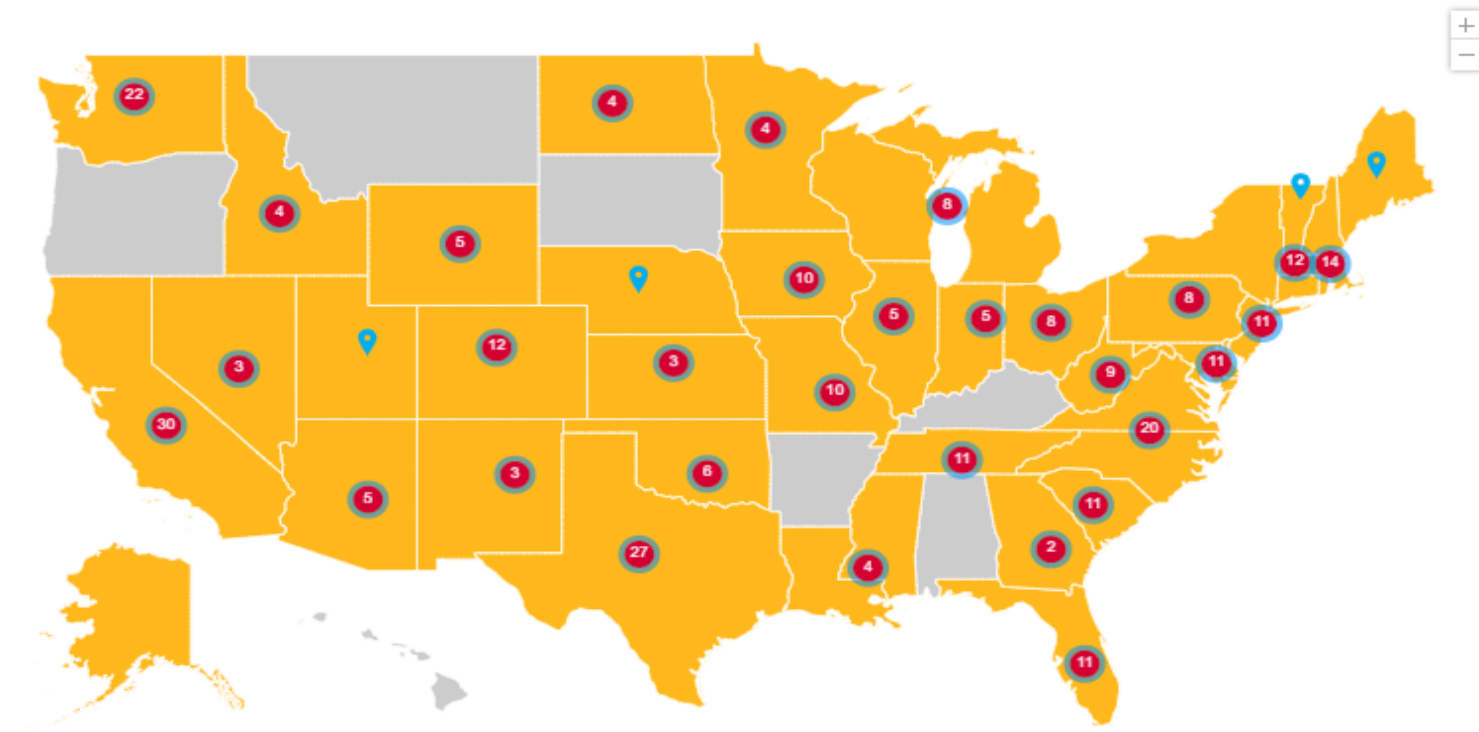

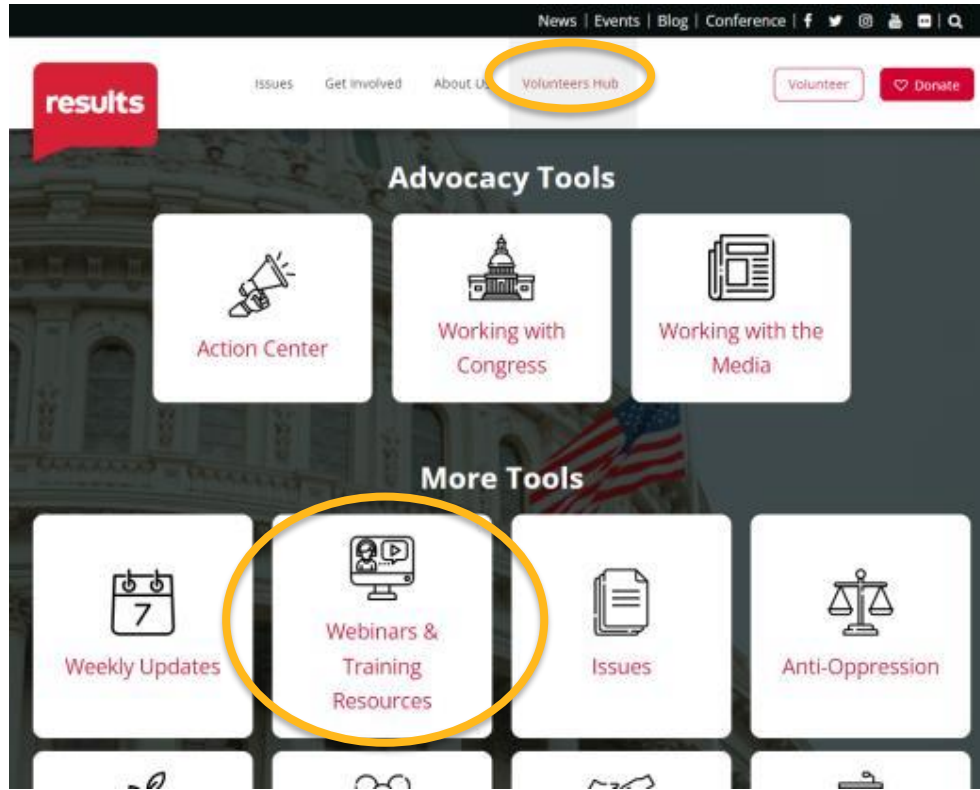
