**But Congress gets final say.** So that's where we focused.













# White House proposal:

Maternal and Child Health	 90% cut
Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance	 \$0
Nutrition	 \$0
Tuberculosis	 50% cut
Global Fund to Fight AIDS, TB & Malaria	 50% cut
Global Partnership for Education	 \$0

# Response from Congress:

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<b>Maternal and Child Health</b>	 Restored
<b>Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance</b>	 Restored
<b>Nutrition</b>	 Increased
<b>Tuberculosis</b>	 Restored
<b>Global Fund to Fight AIDS, TB &amp; Malaria</b>	 Restored
<b>Global Partnership for Education</b>	 Restored

	President's budget	House bill
<b>Maternal and Child Health</b>	 90% cut	 Restored
<b>Gavi, the Vaccine Alliance</b>	 \$0	 Restored
<b>Nutrition</b>	 \$0	 Increased
<b>Tuberculosis</b>	 50% cut	 Restored
<b>Global Fund to Fight AIDS, TB &amp; Malaria</b>	 50% cut	 Restored
<b>Global Partnership for Education</b>	 \$0	 Restored

**Then the White House tried to claw back money Congress had already set aside for global health.**

**Again, Congress gets final say.** So again, that's where we stayed focused.

# The Senate's red-line on cuts:

...Provided, That none of the amounts rescinded under this paragraph shall be from the unobligated balances for the following programs: HIV/AIDS, Tuberculosis, Malaria, Nutrition, or Maternal and Child Health

S.Amdt.2853 — 119th Congress

**This isn't a sign that we're done.** The rescissions package still passed. The House bill still gutted other critical work. Millions of people are still being denied TB treatment, nutrition, education, and more.

**But it's a sign that you **are** making a difference.** And that we need to keep going.

# Budget Reconciliation

- House and Senate narrowly passed the final budget reconciliation bill in early July; the “One Big Beautiful Bill” or OBBB became law on July 4.
- Will have negative generational impacts for those living in poverty.
- Provides major tax breaks to wealthier Americans and corporations while cutting critical social service programs.

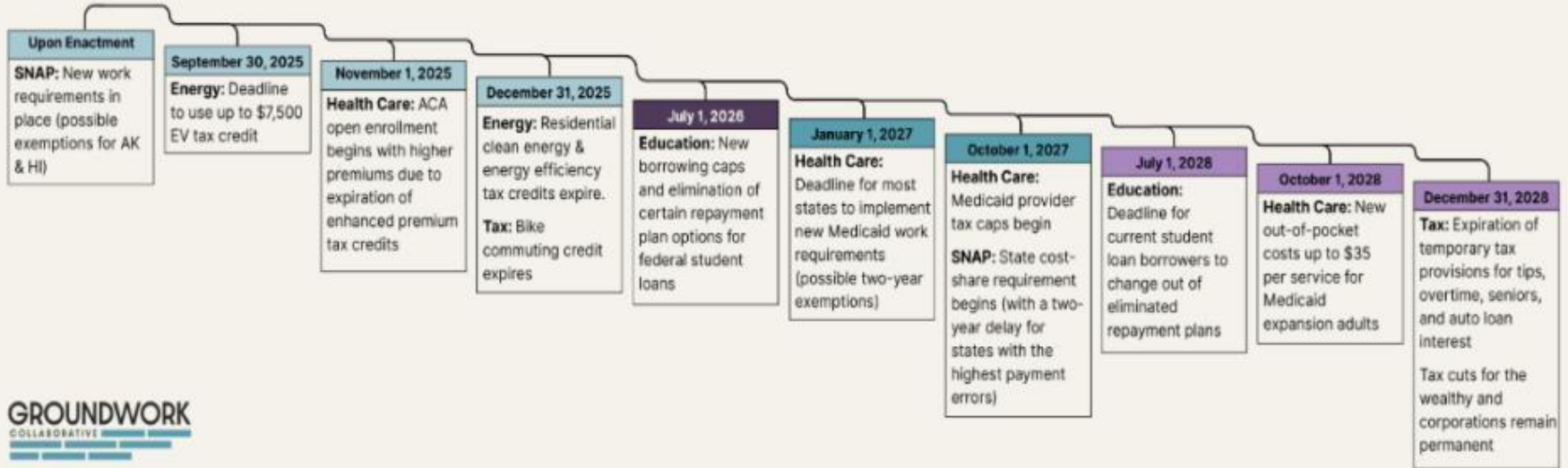
# OBBB Negative Impacts

- 17 million people could lose the health insurance.
- Many rural hospitals may close.
- Newer and harsher work requirements for SNAP targeting already struggling families and individuals.
- 17 million children will remain out of collecting the Child Tax Credit.
- Immigrant families will face devastating losses.

# OBBA Advocacy Wins

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States will share a lower cost of SNAP benefits than first proposed



SNAP work requirements for parents with children will start at age 10 of the child instead of the proposed 7



Requiring families to “pre-certify” for the Earned Income Tax Credit is gone



Only one parent is required to have a Social Security Number instead of the proposal for both parents

# Hold lawmakers accountable in August

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## Talk with members of Congress during the August recess (now through Labor Day)

- Request face-to-face meetings and attend public events while members are home
- Remind them how OBBB will hurt your state
  - **BRAND NEW!** CBPP facts sheets on the impact of OBBB in each state: <https://www.cbpp.org/research/state-budget-and-tax/harmful-republican-megabill-fails-families-children-and-communities-0>
- Meeting requests:
  - Mitigate OBBB's harm by expanding the full Child Tax Credit to all families who qualify.
  - Enough is enough – no more cuts! Urge them to reject any new rescissions.

## Keep generating media highlighting the harmful impacts of the OBBB

- Tell your personal stories of how this legislation will impact you, your family, and your community (use the fact sheets above).
- Remind lawmakers you won't soon forget how they voted.

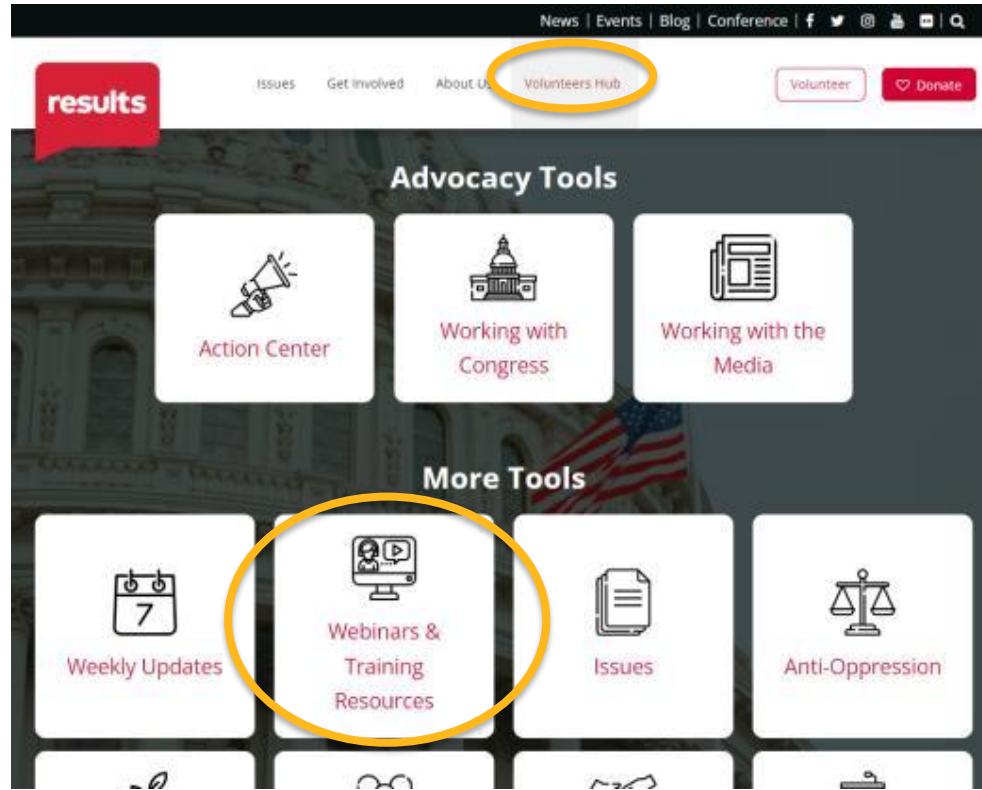
