This isn't a sign that we're done. The rescissions package still passed. The House bill still gutted other critical work. Millions of people are still being denied TB treatment, nutrition, education, and more.

...Provided, That <u>none</u> of the amounts rescinded under this paragraph <u>shall be from</u> the unobligated balances for the following programs: <u>HIV/AIDS</u>, <u>Tuberculosis</u>, <u>Malaria</u>, <u>Nutrition</u>, or <u>Maternal</u> and <u>Child Health</u>

Trump Administration Can Withhold Billions in Aid, Appeals Court Rules


In a 2-to-1 vote, a federal appeals court panel ruled that foreign aid groups that sued to recover funds that President Trump froze cannot challenge the decision.

Funding cuts and program terminations

"I don't have money to buy medicine. I feel sicker every day. My children are small, and they need me to take care of them. I don't know what to do."

"60 to 70% of our operation was supported by USAID, and the suspension has had a high impact... its impact [is] not just [on] us as the host organization, but also the network, the national network, and their structure down to the community."






Coverage of key treatment and prevention interventions

In countries where the Global Fund invests


- HIV: % of people living with HIV on antiretroviral therapy


