children under 5 globally in 2020*

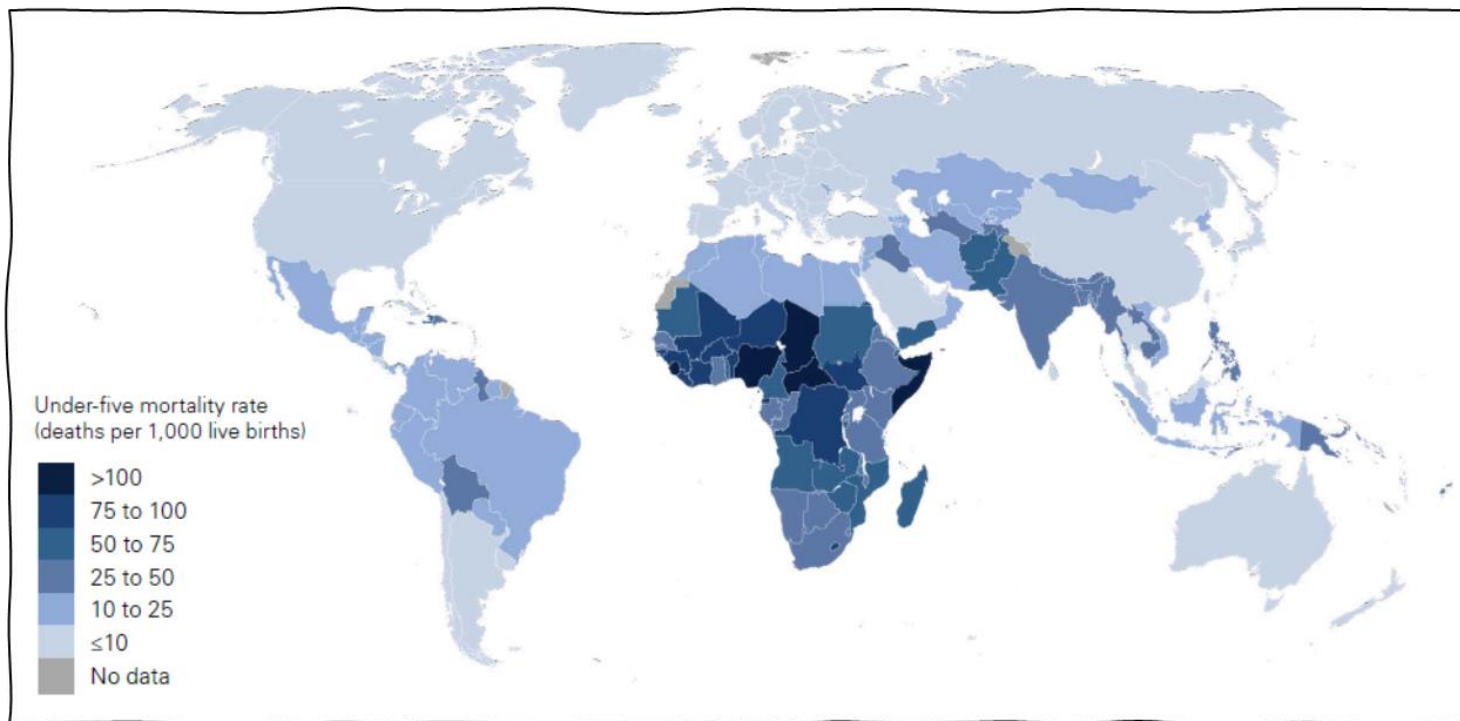


WASTING

Malnutrition is the underlying cause of nearly half (45%) of child deaths.

Samantha Power, head of USAID, at CSIS State of Global Food Security and Nutrition Event:

“Today’s announcement is the most significant commitment that has ever been made to treat severely malnourished children...the largest leap in coverage on record,” said Administrator Power. RUTF treatment for six weeks can help nearly 90 percent of children suffering from wasting recover. “Despite the power of this tool in the fight against child wasting, it is drastically underutilized,” she said.

- **Impact:** The project will enroll **250 women caring for an estimated total of 1,000 children.**

4. Include a **call to action – Bring S. 2956 to the floor for a vote and pass into law!**
5. Submit
