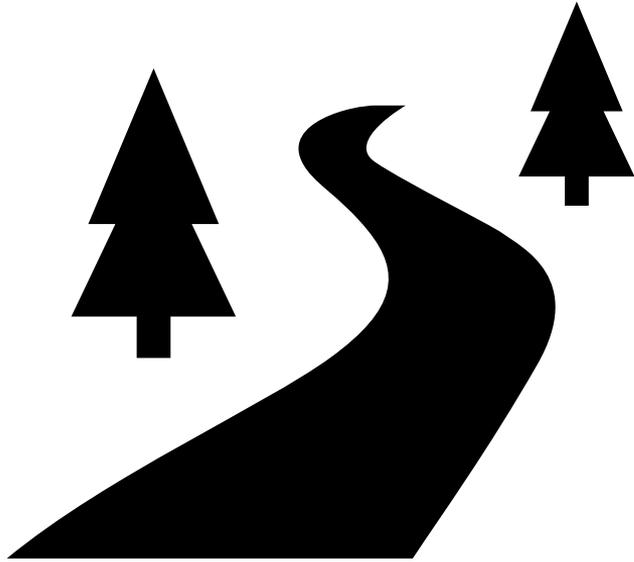

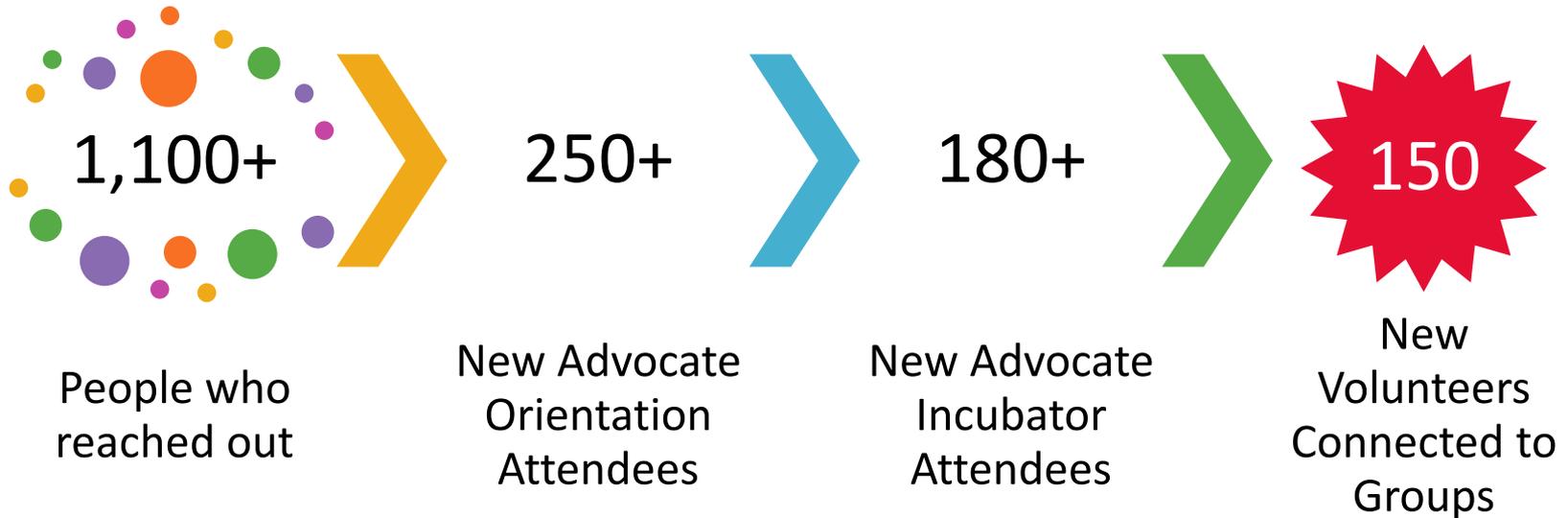

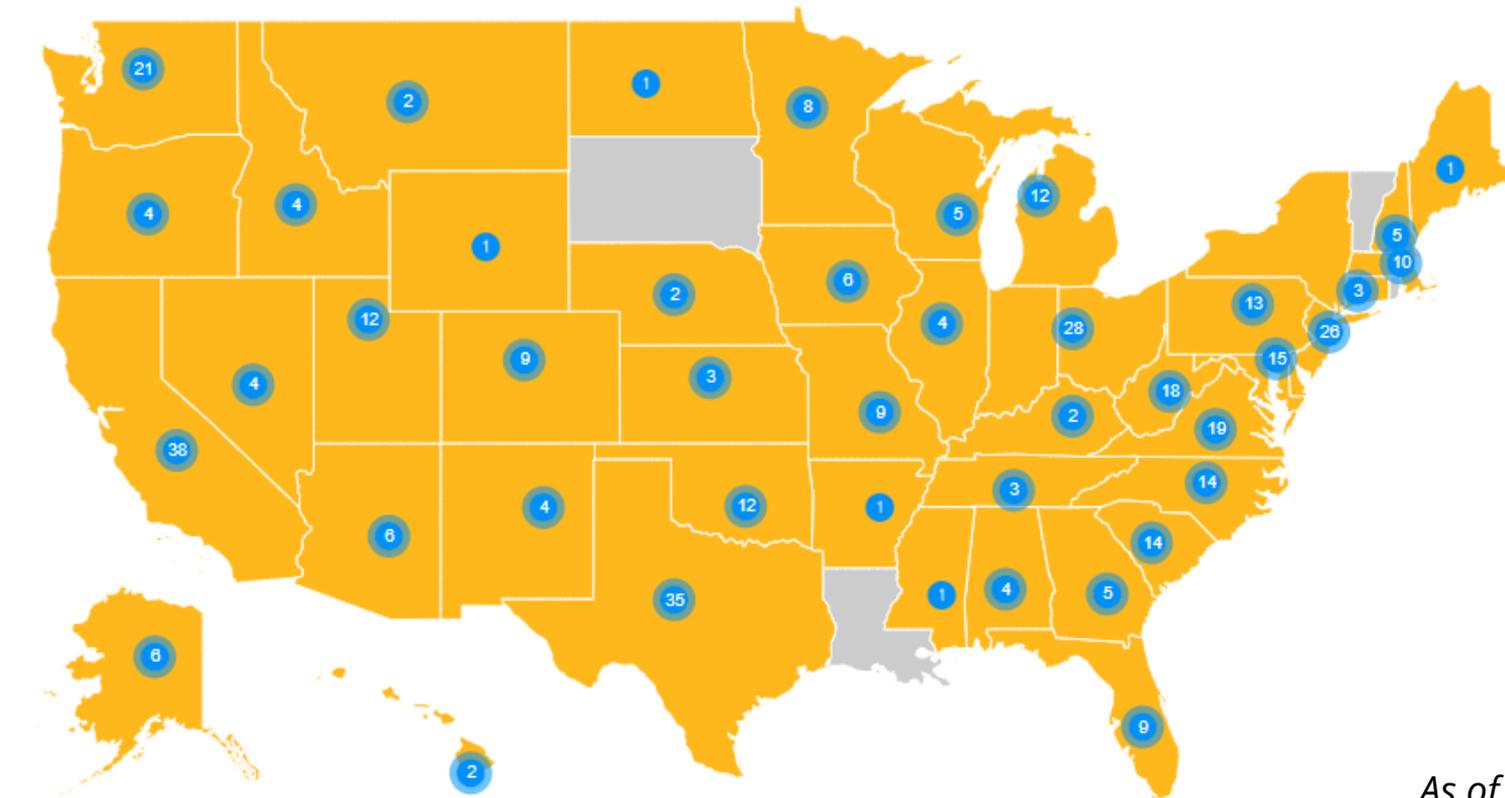

# New Advocate Mentor Achievements

results

- At least 1 new advocate attended 101 congressional meetings (*this is a significant increase than in 2024*) out of 401 congressional meetings!
  - That means new advocates attended 25% of all meetings for **2025!**
- These meetings were held across 31 states!
- The Mentors met four times this year and took the time to discuss **achievements, barriers, best practices**, and **building better relationships** amongst one another.

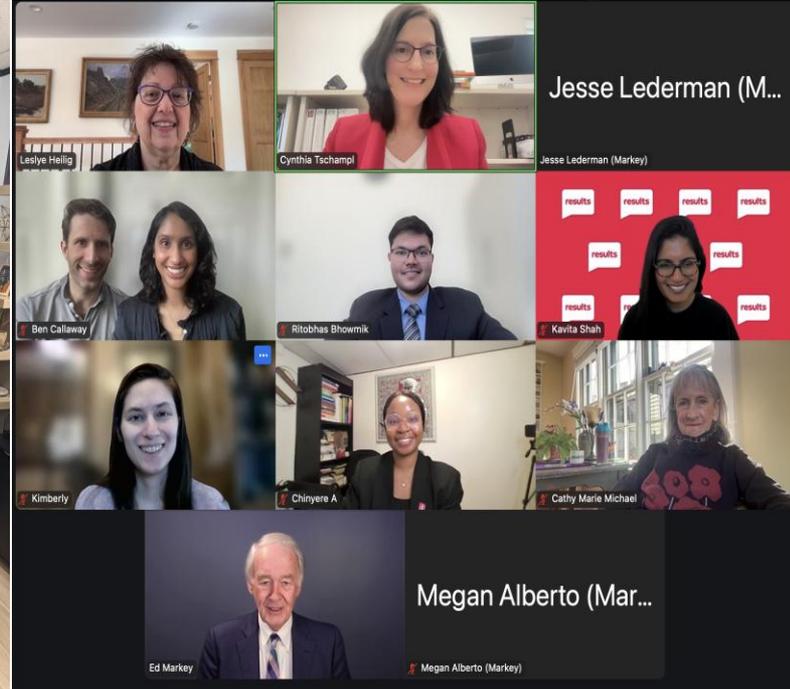

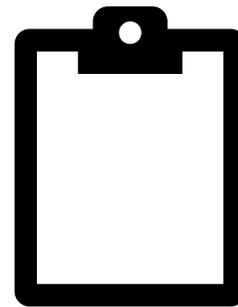

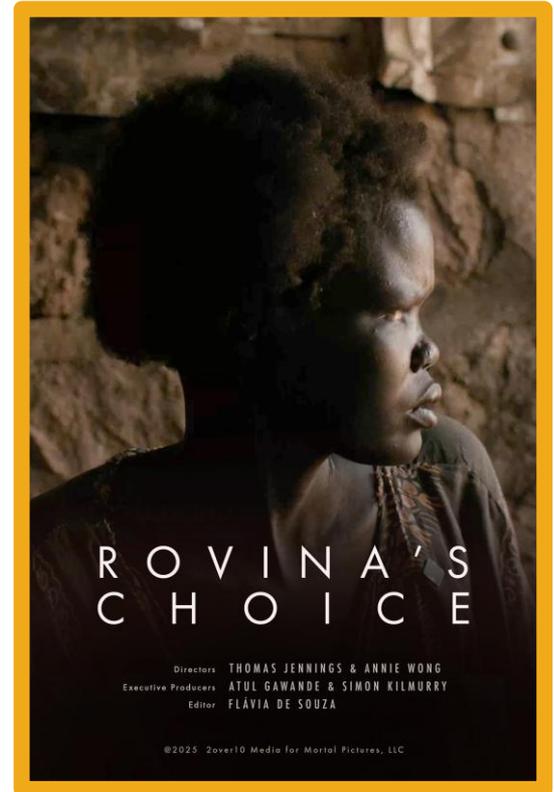
January 21, 2026 | 8-9pm ET
