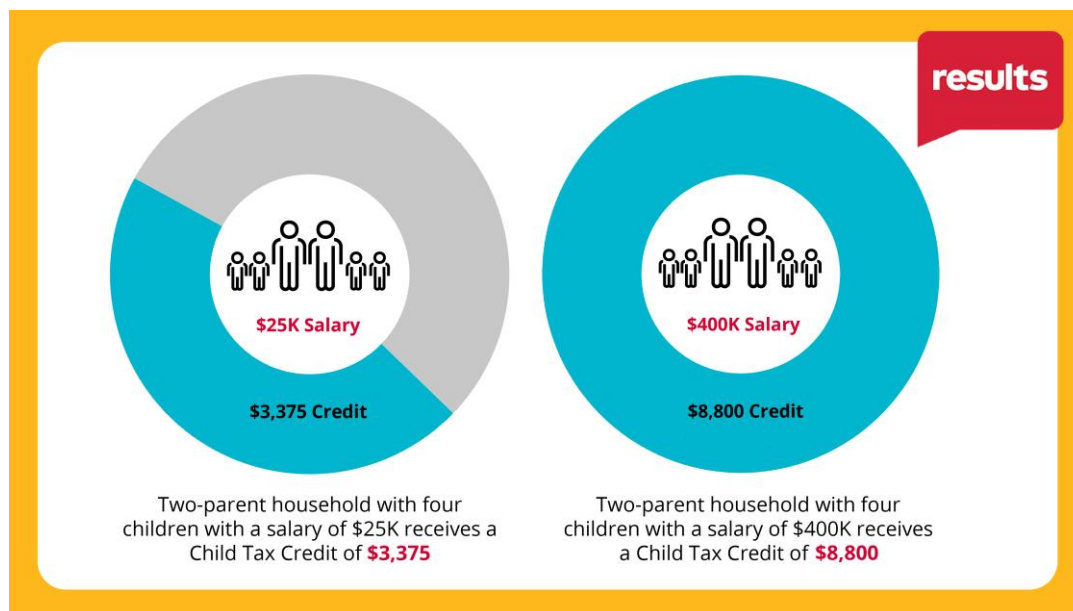


Stronger Start for Working Families Act

Cosponsor the bipartisan Stronger Start for Working Families Act (S.3596). As families continue to struggle with affordability, Congress can and should help.

The Stronger Start for Working Families Act (SSWFA), led by Sens. Hassan (D-NH) and Young (R-IN) would make the Child Tax Credit (CTC) more effective and rewarding for families who work in low wage jobs by:

- **Allowing parents to earn their CTC from their first dollar of income.** Current CTC law gives parents 15 cents for every dollar earned over \$2,500 per year. The SSWFA would start to fix this flawed phase-in by allowing parents to accrue the CTC from their first dollar earned. For millions of families working in low wage jobs, this would mean an extra \$375 in their tax returns each year.
- **Better target benefits to those with the greatest need.** Parents earning as much as \$400,000 receive the full CTC while parents earning as little as \$25,000 per year may receive less than half. Federal funds should be better targeted to families working in low wage jobs.
