

Communication templates

Use these templates when you are reaching out to "warm leads" and other people in your network who you want to engage with. You can customize them to fit your needs.

Where are my lists of warm leads?

Tips

- Prioritize your list based on individuals you have been 1) introduced to, 2) have perhaps joined your group at one point but you haven't seen lately, and 3) are most recent contacts.
- Share that you are local people are energized hearing from folks in their community. Remind them they reached out to us about volunteering.
- Make your invitation friendly and exciting.
- Do not be discouraged. The door closes to RESULTS once you stop contacting them so if you don't hear back right away, follow up again in a few weeks.
- Have a concrete next step (inviting them to a one-on-one meeting, event, group meeting, lobby prep, etc.).

Email templates

Invite them for a one-on-one conversation about advocacy

Hello [Name],

Invite them to lobby with your RESULTS group

Invite them to attend an event or group meeting

Hello [Name],

Phone script (adapt to fit your needs)

General script

I'm calling to see if you'd ever like to get involved with our RESULTS group here in [Your city/state]? [One to two sentences about your group.] We'd love to have you join us for action!

Script for inviting them to a one-on-one meeting about advocacy

I'm calling to see if you'd like to set up a time for us to chat individually about advocacy. I'd love to hear about your interests and what initially interested you in RESULTS.

Script for inviting them to an event

I'm calling to invite you to a community event happening in [Location] on [Date and time]. [Share event details.] It will be an inspiring moment of connection and advocacy. If you're available that day, we'd love to see you there.

Script for inviting them to a lobby meeting with your RESULTS group

I'm calling to see if you would like to attend a lobby meeting with [Sen/Rep name]'s office? We will be discussing [Issue(s)] and the more constituents we have present, the more powerful our message will be. You can simply attend to demonstrate your support for these issues. We will provide all the training and resources you need to make it easy!

Is that something that might be of interest to you?

(Listen to their answer):

- If yes, great! Confirm their email address and let them know you'll follow up with an email.
- If no, ask if they want to participate with RESULTS in some other way, like attending an upcoming congressional meeting, taking action with the group, etc.
- (If no...) Thanks for letting me know! I'll make a note on our end. Have a good day!

Voicemail
